Master of Science (MSc) Scholarship

 - c. Bachelor of Dental Surgery
 - d. Bachelor of Science in Nursing
 - e. Any other non-classified degree/qualification equivalent to (i) above, Bachelor of Animal Health and Bachelor of Animal Science where Pathology, Microbiology; and Parasitology that were taken and passed.
- 2). Holders of the following classified degrees, at upper second class honours, of the University of Nairobi, or equivalent qualification from a University recognized by the Senate of the University of Nairobi:
 - a. General Bachelor of Science degree, where Zoology was taken and passed
 - b. BSc. in Biology
 - c. BSc in Microbiology and Biotechnology
 - d. BSc. in Biomedical Sciences and Laboratory Technology
 - e. BSc. in Food Science and Technology
 - f. Holders of the above-classified degrees, at lower second class honours, of the University of Nairobi, or equivalent qualification from a University recognized by the Senate of the University of Nairobi and at least 3 years research/ work experience

g. Holders of the above-classified degrees, at pass level, of the University of Nairobi, or equivalent qualification from a University recognized by the Senate of the University of Nairobi and post graduate diploma in relevant areas.
